

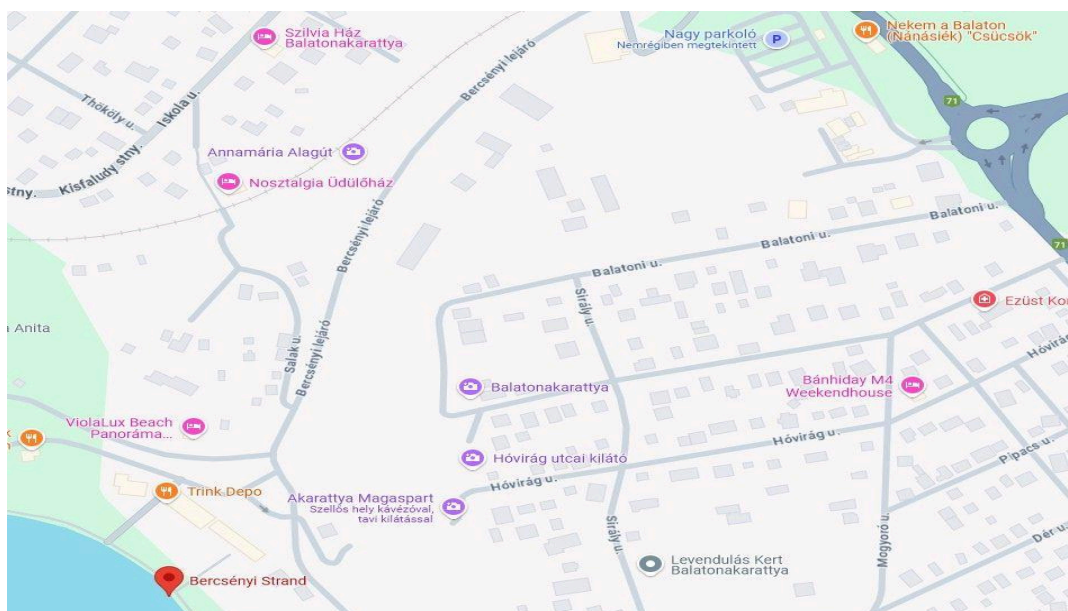
# Bercsényi Beach

Due to its proximity to the Bercsényi beach in Balatonakarattya, it is an ideal choice for those coming from the capital, as it takes about 1 hour to travel by car, and it is about a 15-minute walk from the nearest bus or train station. The beach is the largest central beach of Balatonakarattya, with a shady, well-kept waterfront area of nearly 2.5 ha, where a 300-meter-long concrete beach awaits those who want to bathe with 6 non-slip beach steps. The trees on the beach area provide a large shaded area, but at the same time there is no shortage of sunny areas. Its green area and trees are well cared for.



There are 3 playgrounds for children on the beach, a barrier-free water block for those with limited mobility, and a baby-mom and baby-dad room was designed based on child-friendly aspects. There are 8 catering units, 1 rental and 1 water adventure park on the beach. It is possible to rent sunbeds, deckchairs and safes at the main cash desk of the beach. When redeeming beach services, we accept cash, bank card and OTP beauty card. Outside of opening hours, the beach can be visited freely as a public park. There is also a beach library and playhouse on weekends. A bright spot in terms of beach services is the electric minibus, which transports passengers in the afternoons on the steep incline of Bercsényi to the Napfény parking lot at the top of the hill. Bercsényi beach participates in Mozdulj Balaton every year! in the program series and in addition, it is possible to use the foot tennis court and beach handball court, so guests who want active recreation will be happy to visit our beach.

When approaching Bercsényi and Lidó beaches in Akarattya, visitors have to take into account the difference in level. Due to its unique characteristics, the settlement is located on a high bank, while the beaches are located directly at the "base" of this high bank. It is possible to go down by car, bicycle or on foot via the Bercsényi exit and the Koppány exit. Another possibility to go down on foot is the flight of stairs starting from the lookout point on the Kisfaludy promenade, which leads to the Lidó beach. Getting to the beaches is facilitated by an electric minibus operated by the municipality.



# BEACH REGULATIONS

The Community Beach Bercsényi is owned and operated by the Government of the Community of Balatonakarattya (8172 Balatonakarattya, Rákóczi street. 55. telefon: 0688-658-811).

The beach is open from 8:00 to 19:00 hours. After 19:00 hours beach services are over and the beach can be used on one's own responsibility.

The borders of the beach are indicated by:  
white signs depicting a black torso in blue rippling water, placed on the beach,  
cylinder shaped buoys with red and white vertical stripes placed in the water.

The fee established by order of local government for use of the beach must be paid in advance. Admission tickets to the beach must be bought between 8:00 and 19:00 hours.

Tickets, which have been paid for, but not used, are not refundable.

Children up to the age 3 and persons over age 70 do not need tickets.

Children under 6 as well as children under 14 who cannot swim may bath only with adult supervision, in the area designated for such activity.

One-day tickets entitle the bearer to a single entry. Guests are required to produce their tickets upon request for purpose of control.

Individuals who willfully damage beach furnishing, equipment, vegetation, etc. are financially liable for such damage. Damage caused by children is the responsibility of the adult charged with supervising the child. Individuals who damage beach property may also be prosecuted on misdemeanor charges. Individuals on beach property are obligated to abide by the rules in the Order on Beach Regulations and Entry Fees. Those who violate the rules may be prohibited from using the beach, may be removed from the beach, with the assistance of the police if necessary. Drunken individuals may not use the beach.

## IT IS PROHIBITED

- all behavior which upsets the order of the beach, its safety or others tranquility.
- for those who cannot swim, to use the deep water.
- to take fragile objects into Lake Balaton.
- to bring vehicles, dogs or other animals onto beach territory.
- to leave food waste, paper waste, other litter and cigarette butts on beach territory –except in the designated waste receptacles.
- to bathe at night.
- the water depth at the outer border buoys is 1,8 m, bathers go beyond this area at their own risk and responsibility.
- to fish during beach operating hours.
- to use soap, shampoo and other detergents in Lake Balaton and to pollute the water in any other way.
- to make unjustified noise, use radios or tape recorders at high volume.
- to use marine vehicles (motor-boats, row-boats, sail-boats )on beach premises.

**In the event of a 1st degree storm warning-flashing light signal 45 times per minute – it is forbidden to bathe or remain in marine vehicles more than 500 meters from the shore.**

**In the event of a 2nd degree storm warning-flashing light signal 90 times per minute- bathing is prohibited.**

Boat and watersports equipment traffic in the areas outside of the bathing zone must be reckoned with.

Next to the swimming zone a harbor entrance is located, therefore it is prohibited to pass the western border of the swimming zone indicated by buoys. Swimming equipment may only be used in the proximity of other swimmers, provided it does not endanger them.

The use of watersports equipment (surfboards, paddle-boats, etc.) is permitted outside beach premises on the condition marine traffic rules are followed.

The operator of the beach is not responsible for valuables or money left in cabins or unsupervised on beach premises.

These regulations are valid from 25 May 2023 until further notice.
