

Bercsényi Beach

Due to its proximity to Budapest, Bercsényi Beach in Balatonakarattya is an ideal destination for visitors arriving from the capital. It is approximately a one-hour drive away and about a 15-minute walk from the nearest bus stop and railway station.

Balatonakarattya's largest central beach covers nearly 2.5 hectares and offers a well-maintained, shaded waterfront with a 300-metre-long concrete shoreline and six non-slip beach stairways for safe access to the water.



The trees throughout the beach provide extensive shaded areas, while plenty of sunny spots are also available. The green areas and trees are carefully maintained.

The beach features three playgrounds for children, an accessible restroom facility for visitors with reduced mobility, and family-friendly baby care rooms for parents. There are also eight catering units, one rental service and one inflatable water adventure park.



Sun loungers, deck chairs and lockers can be rented at the main ticket office. Cash, bank cards and OTP SZÉP Cards are accepted for all beach services. Outside opening hours, the beach is freely accessible as a public park. A beach library and children's playhouse operate on weekends.



A unique beach service is the electric shuttle bus, which transports passengers in the afternoons up the Bercsényi access road to the Napfény car park at the top of the hill. Every year, Bercsényi Beach participates in the 'Move Balaton!' programme series. Visitors can also enjoy foot tennis and beach handball courts, making the beach an excellent choice for active recreation.

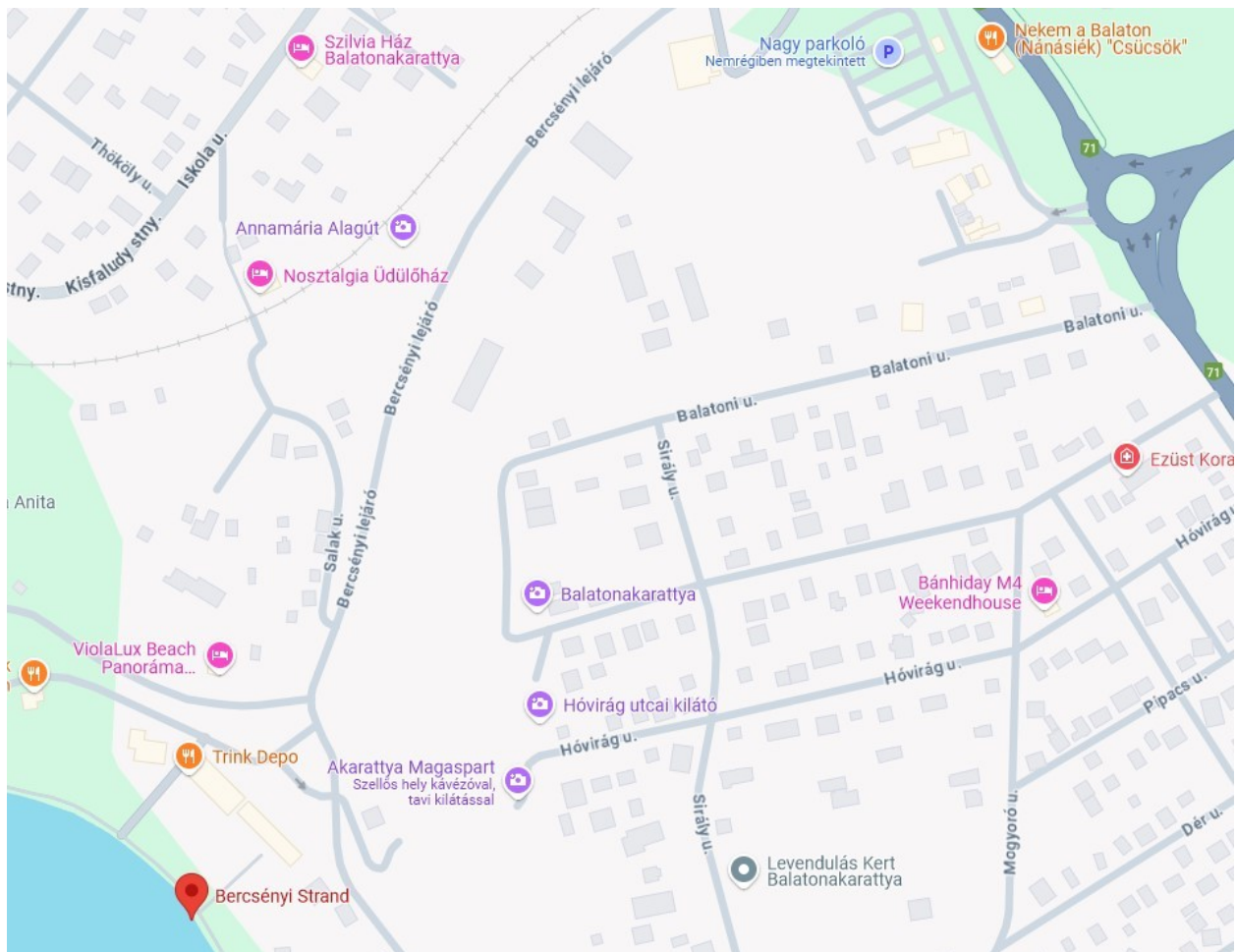

The beach is open from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. After 7:00 p.m the beach services cease, everyone can use the beach at their own risk.

Getting There:

When visiting the Bercsényi and Lidó beaches, please note the significant change in elevation. The village is situated on a high bluff, while the beaches are located at its base. The beaches can be reached by car, bicycle or on foot via the Bercsényi or Koppány access roads. Pedestrians may also use the staircase leading from the Kisfaludy Promenade lookout to the vicinity of Lidó Beach. An electric shuttle bus operated by the municipality also assists visitors in reaching the beaches.

BEACH REGULATIONS

The Community Beach Bercsényi is owned and operated by the Government of the Community of Balatonakarattya (8172 Balatonakarattya, Rákóczi street. 55. telefon: 0688-658-811).

The beach is open from 8:00 to 19:00 hours.
After 19:00 hours beach services are over and the beach can be used on one's own responsibility.

The borders of the beach are indicated by:
white signs depicting a black torso in blue rippling water, placed on the beach,
cylinder shaped buoys with red and white vertical stripes placed in the water.

The fee established by order of local government for use of the beach must be paid in advance. Admission tickets to the beach must be bought between 8:00 and 19:00 hours.

Tickets, which have been paid for, but not used, are not refundable.

Children up to the age 3 and persons over age 70 do not need tickets.

Children under 6 as well as children under 14 who cannot swim may bath only with adult supervision, in the area designated for such activity.

One-day tickets entitle the bearer to a single entry. Guests are required to produce their tickets upon request for purpose of control.

Individuals who willfully damage beach furnishing, equipment, vegetation, etc. are financially liable for such damage. Damage caused by children is the responsibility of the adult charged with supervising the child. Individuals who damage beach property may also be prosecuted on misdemeanor charges. Individuals on beach property are obligated to abide by the rules in the Order on Beach Regulations and Entry Fees. Those who violate the rules may be prohibited from using the beach, may be removed from the beach, with the assistance of the police if necessary. Drunken individuals may not use the beach.

IT IS PROHIBITED

all behavior which upsets the order of the beach, its safety or others tranquillity.
for those who cannot swim, to use the deep water.
to take fragile objects into Lake Balaton.
to bring vehicles, dogs or other animals onto beach territory.
to leave food waste, paper waste, other litter and cigarette butts on beach territory –except in the designated waste receptacles.
to bathe at night.
the water depth at the outer border buoys is 1,8 m, bathers go beyond this area at their own risk and responsibility.
to fish during beach operating hours.
to use soap, shampoo and other detergents in Lake Balaton and to pollute the water in any other way.
to make unjustified noise, use radios or tape recorders at high volume.
to use marine vehicles (motor-boats, row-boats, sail-boats) on beach premises.

In the event of a 1st degree storm warning-flashing light signal 45 times per minute – it is forbidden to bathe or remain in marine vehicles more than 500 meters from the shore.

In the event of a 2nd degree storm warning-flashing light signal 90 times per minute- bathing is prohibited.

Boat and watersports equipment traffic in the areas outside of the bathing zone must be reckoned with.

Next to the swimming zone a harbor entrance is located, therefore it is prohibited to pass the western border of the swimming zone indicated by buoys. Swimming equipment may only be used in the proximity of other swimmers, provided it does not endanger them.

The use of watersports equipment (surfboards, paddle-boats, etc.) is permitted outside beach premises on the condition marine traffic rules are followed.

The operator of the beach is not responsible for valuables or money left in cabins or unsupervised on beach premises.

These regulations are valid from 25 May 2023 until further notice.
